## Itinerary

### March 9, Day 1 – Depart Atlanta

Depart Atlanta for our flight to Tel Aviv. Dinner and breakfast will be served aboard.

### March 10, Day 2 – Arrival at Ben-Gurion Airport

We arrive, tired but elated to be in this blessed land. We will be met by our representative who will assist us through customs. We will board our deluxe motor-coach and transfer to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

### March 11, Day 3 – Megiddo – Mt. Carmel – Nazareth – Cana

After a delicious Israeli breakfast we will make our way to Megiddo, one of Solomon's fortress cities and guardian of the Valley of Armageddon. Then we will drive up Mount Carmel to Muhraga, "Place of the Burning," where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal. Next stop Nazareth the boyhood home of Jesus, and visit Mary's Well. We drive to Cana, the site of the first miracle, continuing back to Tiberias for a stop will be the Jordan River Baptismal Site (Yardenit). Those wanting to be baptized in the Jordan this will be the time. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. Tiberias

### March 12, Day 4 – Capernaum – Tabgha – Mt. of Beatitudes – Beit Shean – Jericho – Jerusalem

After breakfast this morning, we take a boat ride across Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, the center of Jesus's Ministry and see the ruins of an ancient synagogue. Continue to Tabgha where the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish took place and then on to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered his "Sermon on the Mount". Leaving Tiberias we will visit the excavations at Beit She'an. Traveling past Jericho, view the Mount of Temptation, we will all so be able to see the Dead Sea as we make our way to Jerusalem. After a brief overview of the Old City of Jerusalem we drive to Bethlehem, (the birthplace of Jesus and King David) past Rachel's Tome, view Shepherd's field we stop to visit the Church of the Nativity. And Manger Square and stop at one of the famous Bethlehem gift shops. We arrive at our hotel for Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

### March 13, Day 5 – Old City of Jerusalem

After breakfast we start our day at the top of the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Old Jerusalem, then walk down the Mount of Olives to the chapel that commemorates our Lord weeping over Jerusalem. Finally we come to the Garden of Gethsemane where we will see eight venerable olive trees, leafy offshoots of the trees that witnessed our Saviour's agony. We cross the Kidron Valley to the House of Caiaphas where Jesus was held prisoner. We will visit the traditional Upper Room and tomb of King David. We enter through the Dung Gate leading to the Western Wall and the Temple Mount where we will see the Dome of the Rock and the El Aksa Mosque. Then we will proceed to the Muslim Quarter where we will visit the beautiful Crusader Church dedicated to St. Anne and the nearby Pool of Bethesda. We'll walk the 14 Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem

### March 14, Day 6 – Leisure Day

We have a day of leisure to shopping. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem

### March 15, Day 7 – New City of Jerusalem

Full day tour of the New City of Jerusalem, driving via the Knesset (Israel's Parliament) to the Israel Museum, which comprises art and archaeology and visit the Shrine of the Book housing the Dead Sea Scrolls. Continue to the Model City of Jerusalem from the time of the Second Temple. We will close our day with a visit to Calvary and the Garden Tomb, a peaceful spot where we can remember Christ's crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. Dinner Overnight Jerusalem

### March 16, Day 8 – Sinai Desert – Cairo

We say farewell to Jerusalem with a clear understanding of Psalms 122:6 "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem" We head South past the Dead Sea, Qumran, Massada. We travel past Sodom and Gomorrah (believed to be under the sea). Genesis 19-13, "but the men were wicked and sinners before the Lord exceedingly...then the Lord rained upon Sodom and Gomorrah brimstone and fire". We cross the border into Egypt at Eilat and start through the Sinai Desert. We have been driving through the same land that the Children of Israel traveled on leaving Egypt. Dinner and overnight Cairo

### March 17, Day 9 – Giza – Pyramid – Sphinx – Museum

After breakfast we begin our day with a drive to Giza to enjoy the splendor of the Pyramids, one of the remaining Seven Wonders of the World, the Pyramid of Cheops, the largest and most renowned of Egypt's Pyramids. Nearby, see the Pyramid of Chephren and next to it the enigmatic giant figure of the Sphinx. The smaller Pyramid of Mykerinos completes the magnificent site. Then we drive back to Cairo for a visit to the Egyptian Archaeological Museum, the most famous museum in Egypt. See the fine collection of pharaonic antiquities in the world from the Old Kingdom, the Middle Kingdom, Sakkara, Meidoum and Giza. The world-renowned treasures of King Tutankhamen are also on display. With a visit to Old Cairo, the Church of St. Sergius, the Hanging Church. Then we make a stop at a Papyrus factory to learn the ancient art of making Papyrus paper. Dinner and overnight Cairo

### March 18, Day 10 – Departure

We transfer to the airport for our flight home.
